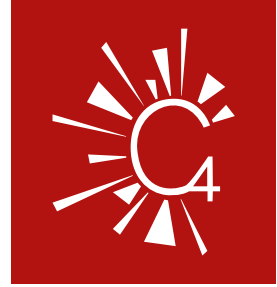


# Minutes of the N+238<sup>th</sup> meeting of C4
