### 10.1 Role division

### 10.2 External members in lunch lectures

We allow externals to join our lunch lectures, and therefore we make costs for externals coming to lunch lectures, **Maiko Cheng** mentions that almost no other association does this (except Simon Stevin who charge 1 euro). **Maiko Cheng** is wondering whether we should charge some money. We are not entirely sure how Simon Stevin does this.

125 **Celine de Jong** mentions that last year we had the inversed problem, where too little people were signing up. She believes you do not want to “scare them off”. Also not providing lunch for the externals would scare them off.

**Maiko Cheng** does mention that this year is the first time that Scope and MyFuture

130 is used by almost everyone. **Maiko Cheng** does say they sell lunch lectures with the promise that the attendance is approximately +/- 60. Next year we could then sell our lunch lectures for more money as at least +/- 70 people show up!

### 10.3 Clothing

**Bartjan Henkemans** is a bit on the fence because of competition (posting CSE vacancies via other associations). **Lora Šimić** mentions that Euflex is going to suffer from this. **Celine de Jong** is in general also somewhat hesitant. There should be agreements between

This should be discussed at the FSE-AB, it is going to be discussed at the FSE-EB, where **Maiko Cheng** will not be present. For now, Intermate and Simon might want to join. **Maiko Cheng** will approach D.S.A. Pattern about this.
